The Trailblazers celebrated Earth Day a bit early, on April 17 by participating in a work day at El Prado Park, coordinated by LDPOA Vice President Ron Hunt and the Parks and Trails Committee. There were about 20 volunteers total that split their efforts between the park area and the horse camp. We averaged about 4 hours of work per person, or 80 hours total on the cleanup efforts.

The results were fantastic! At the park, volunteers cleaned and painted the barbeques and picnic tables, mowed lawns and cut weeds, cleaned the restrooms and cleaned up the playground area. Two dumpsters were donated to haul away the debris. The parking area was also scraped and smoothed.

At the horse camp, volunteers mowed lots of weeds and cleared parking areas, trimmed trees, and restored a culvert that had previously been installed so additional area could be accessed. A new hitching rack donated by Bill and Jane Cloud was installed. Water access was also reviewed for future improvements. Trail markers were installed at trailheads to indicate where the easements and trails connected to the camp. Measurements were also made for estimates to purchase gravel, in the event that we secure additional funding later this year.

Thanks to the Little League organization that maintains the baseball field, that area is looking great too.
