Discussion:

- Our first workday was a success! 8 people (Chrystina, Dan, Kim, Darlene, Diana, Mitch, Sue, Shelby) We worked for 2 hours (total of 16 combined hours) and cleared a decent part of the trail around Alfier Park. This will be a wonderful hiking trail, once we get it cleared.
- Jane Cloud and I have successfully signed up for the Adopt A Highway. Our first cleaning will be in July. Highway 132 between mile marker 9.4 – 11.65. I believe it to be just East of Don Pedro Market. This is both East and West bound shoulders. Caltrans encourages us to utilize the recyclables, this will be a small revenue as well.
- We participated in the Community Yard Sale and made \$104. Met a few neighbors that purchased a couple maps. People also asked us horse related questions. I feel, overall, it was a great opportunity to represent The Trailblazers and let the community know who we are.
- HOA accountant, Monica, has been a huge help and has offered to continue tracking our books. She has also mentioned, in the past, the Trailblazers used the HOA tax exempt status to apply for Grants.
 - We tried getting Caltrans to make the Adopt a Highway checks to the HOA but because they are not on the waiver, we cannot have the checks made out to them. If we changed the name on the waiver, then it would have the HOA name on the Adopt a Highway sign. With our name, it gets more people familiar with our group.

- June 24th is our next horse ride. Meeting at Alfier Park ride out is at 9am. Expect a 3 hour ride.
