Treasurers Report: Beginning balance was \$240 plus new contributions of \$132 for a total of \$372. We had donations by Lions Club, OSH and Andy's Hardware. After plastic sheeting was purchased for Kiosk, the ending balance was \$41.89. The Discoverer article helped with the charitable contributions.

Articles: Discussion that Foothill Express is selective about which articles they print. Ron will discuss with them that this is a part of the Property Owners activities and will try to obtain commitment for printing submissions.

Terrie noted that we need continued participation with the LDPOA to foster their support.

Kiosk: discussed donations from the community and their support. Thanks to Bill Cloud for donating the labor. The Kiosk is half done. Location for the Kiosk was discussed. Dave showed a sample of the map that he is developing that will be posted on the Kiosk.

Website: Feedback on the proposed \$40 fee for a web link was that this is a reasonable cost but that business owners would want to see "counter" data before committing to ensure there was adequate internet traffic to justify their investment. Riders are starting to log their riding hours.

Spring Hike and Ride: We will join efforts with the John Muir celebration to help promote our event. It will take place on June 4 at 10:00 am. Brenda is coordinating publicity and Monica is logistics coordinator. We need local vendors and community service groups to participate. We need VOLUNTEERS!! Kim O'Mara is donating chocolate and meat snacks that the Trailblazers can sell for fundraising. The newly donated playground needs to be installed. Need trash cans and signs. Christina will be taking photos as part of the fundraiser.

Violations: Carmelita Ln. – the homeowner on lot 193 has agreed to remove the fence to allow for passage to open area/Carmelita Pond Trail. Jalapa – letters have been sent and there have been meetings with some property owners. 3 owners that are not responding have been referred to the county for enforcement. This area is starting to get marked by us and with the county's assistance, we hope that the Jalapa trail will be opened again to hike or ride thur there.

Trail Advisory Committee: this group has been formed by the county of Mariposa to deal with trail easement issues. Currently, it is establishing protocol and procedures for dealing with the reporting and follow-up of easement violations to the county.

Alfier Park: this is located on the corner of Paraiso and Ranchito. We discussed plans for improvement to make it a day use park and hike/ride area. A plan has been presented to the Owners Association as it is on LDPOA land. This is a long term project that we would like to get started this year on. Stay tuned for scheduled clean up.

Clothing order: we reviewed choices that we have decided on. We would like to finalize the order by the end of April. Terrie will send an e-mail with details to facilitate the order, hope to finalize at the next meeting so items will be received prior to the Hike and Ride Day event.
